Your Child's Rights in School

- 1. You have the right to request a meeting to discuss your child's progress in the classroom or to seek evaluations or assessments for services in the schools.
- 2. Your child has a right to be free from bullying and harassment.
- 3. You have the right to be notified if your child's classes will be changed.
- 4. You have the right to have your child's IEP reviewed annually.
- 5. You have the right to hire your own evaluator if you want a second opinion about the school psychologist's testing. However, the responsibility of payment will be yours.
- 6. You have the right to bring your own advocate to your child's Section 504 or IEP meeting, whether that person is a clinician, family member, or friend.
- 7. You have the right to give your opinion, but do it in a respectful way.
- 8. You have the right to remove your child from a school. Try to use other methods of working with the school before you take this step.
- 9. You have the right to home school your child, but be aware of the time and effort involved in homeschooling.
- 10. You have a right to be notified of any meetings being held regarding your child.
- 11. You have the right to hire an attorney. Be aware that this can lead to increased cost, time, and energy.
- 12. Your child has a right to the accommodations agreed to on his or her IEP or Section 504 plan.
